## RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 5 Friday, 11 April 2025 Question No. 294

MR CAIN: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services -

- 1. What measures have the ACT Government taken to implement its policy on reducing registration costs for all trailers, caravans and campers from 1 July 2025.
- 2. How will the reduction in registration costs for trailers and caravans be implemented.
- 3. Are there any specific eligibility criteria for households to receive the full registration fee waiver for single axle trailers.

## Ms Tara Cheyne MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

- 1. Implementation of reduced registration fees for trailers, caravans and camper trailers is currently under consideration.
- 2. Any change in registration fees will be administered by including the determined fees in a legislative instrument, as per Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*. The determined fees will be inputted to the relevant systems by Access Canberra and included on registration renewal reminders to registered operators of affected vehicles registered in the ACT.
- 3. Implementation of reduced registration fees for trailers, caravans and camper trailers is currently under consideration.
