**MR BRADDOCK:** To ask the Minister for Transport —

1. What has been the impact of Bustech going into administration on the contract (GS0243294.210) for the delivery of buses.
2. How many buses are expected to be delivered in 2025.
3. Which suppliers will be responsible for the delivery of the buses mentioned in part (2).

**Mr Chris Steel MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:**

1. Transport Canberra have received thirteen Scania BusTech low emission buses under the contract with Scania Finance Australia Pty Ltd (GS0243294.210), prior to being notified by Scania that their sub-contractor, BusTech Group, would be going into voluntary administration. Delivery of the thirteen, outstanding vehicles under the contract has been delayed.
2. Transport Canberra are working with the primary contractor, Scania Australia, to agree on the how the remainder of the contract will be managed. At this stage no commitment to bus delivery timeframes has been agreed.
3. As above.
