RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 30 1 June 2023 Question No. 1246

MRS KIKKERT: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services —

- (1) Are there any plans to use Federal Black Spot Program funding to modify any intersections along Kingsford Smith Drive between Southern Cross Drive and Belconnen Way; if so, (a) what are those plans and what are the projected timelines and (b) has any consultation been undertaken with nearby residents and affected road users.
- (2) How long has the Black Spot Funding sign at the intersection of Castieau Street and Kingsford Smith Drive been there.

MR STEEL MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) There are no immediate plans to use Federal Black Spot Program funding for modification of any intersections along Kingsford Smith Drive between Southern Cross Drive and Belconnen Way. Nominations for Black Spot locations are considered annually by Black Spot Consultative Panels which consist of representatives and experts drawn from the community and road user groups, industry, Australian, state, territory and local government.

- (2) The Black Spot funding project signage near the intersection of Kingsford Smith Drive and Castieau Street is associated with the former Black Spot Intersection upgrade of Kingsford Smith Drive and Southern Cross Drive. This project was delivered in the 2017-18 financial year. Roads ACT have scheduled removal of these signs.
