## RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 7 Friday, 16 May 2025 Question No. 439

MS MORRIS: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services —

- 1. How many new footpaths were delivered in the Brindabella electorate by suburb in each reporting period from 2019–20 to date.
- 2. How many requests for new or upgraded footpaths were received during the period referred to in part (1), and how many of those requests remain unfunded.
- 3. How many public lighting upgrades have been delivered in the Brindabella electorate from 2019-20 to date.
- 4. How many lighting faults were reported in the period referred to in part (1).
- 5. What was the average time to repair those faults referred to in part (4) and how many of those faults reported remain unresolved.

- 3. 5,707 luminaire upgrades, with an additional 11 'infill' lighting upgrades were completed in the Brindabella electorate.
- 4. 21,795 faults were reported in the Brindabella electorate.
- 5. The average time to repair was 6.2 days. Of the 21,795 faults identified over the period, 124 remain unresolved.
