RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**Questions on Notice Paper No 1****6 December 2024****Question No. 107****JO CLAY MLA** - To ask the Minister for Homes and New Suburbs:

1. Which lots/blocks in NSW must be, but have not yet been, acquired by the Ginninderry Joint Venture to establish the Ginninderry Conservation Corridor as determined by Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act (EPBC) approvals.
2. What date should the lots, referred to in part (1), have been acquired by, according to EPBC approvals.
3. By what date does the Ginninderry Joint Venture expect to acquire these lots.

MINISTER BERRY MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. The Ginninderry Joint Venture is not required to acquire any blocks in NSW. The Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEW) has recently updated the Ginninderry Joint Venture's *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act* (EPBC) development conditions. The 2020 rezoning of the NSW land now largely facilitates the Ginninderry Joint Venture's compliance with the requirements to acquire the NSW land and the remaining requirements will be adhered to as part of future planning approvals.
