RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 1 Friday, 6 December 2024 Question No. 127

MS NUTTALL MLA: To ask the Minister for Education and Early Childhood

- 1. How many children in the ACT make use of all available hours of free three year old preschool in an average week as a (a) total number and (b) percentage of total eligible children.
- 2. Of children who use less than their total eligible hours, what is the breakdown of hours used.
- 3. What assessments or consultations have been undertaken to determine the reasons for any under-utilisation of free three year old preschool, and what are the reasons as indicated by these assessments/consultation.
- 4. What is the district breakdown of free three year old preschool utilisation rates.
- 5. How many childcare centres have withdrawn from the free three year old preschool program.
- 6. What percentage of centres providing free three year old preschool are at capacity (a) as a total for the ACT and (b) for each district.
- 7. How many centres have partnered with the ACT Government to deliver free three year old preschool.
- 8. How many eligible centres have opted to not partner with the ACT Government for the free three year old preschool program.

YVETTE BERRY MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1. Enrolment but not attendance data is collected for the Three-year-old preschool program. The program is delivered by participating early childhood education and care services within a service's standard operating hours (up to 10.5 hours per day).
- 2. Enrolment but not attendance data is collected for the Three-year-old preschool program.

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- 3. As of Quarter 4 2024, approximately 72% of all eligible three-year-old children in the ACT were enrolled in the Three-year-old preschool program or targeted 3 year-old initiative. No assessment or consultation has been undertaken to determine reasons for families selecting not to participate in the Three-year-old preschool program.
- 4. Enrolment but not attendance/utilisation data is collected for the Three-year-old preschool program. The program is currently offered at multiple services across the following districts:
 - Belconnen: 30 services
 - Central Canberra: 37 services
 - Gungahlin: 27 services
 - Tuggeranong: 27 services
 - Woden, Weston Creek and Molonglo: 20 services
- 5. Three early childhood education and care services withdrew from the program in 2024.
- 6. The Education Directorate does not hold capacity data for early childhood education and care services, including those delivering the Three-year-old preschool program. A service's total approved places is made publicly available on the National Quality Agenda IT System.
- 7. As of Quarter 4 2024, 80 Providers representing 141 services are partnered to deliver the Threeyear-old preschool program.
- 8. In addition to the three services that withdrew from the Three-year-old preschool program in 2024, six eligible services chose not to participate in the program in 2024.
