MR EMERSON: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services —

- 1. How much has the ACT Government paid out in personal injury liability claims, whether through settlements outside of court or otherwise, in relation to damaged footpaths or any other footpath issues, each year for the last five financial years.
- 2. How much has been spent on footpath (a) repairs and (b) upgrades each year for the last five financial years.
