RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**Questions on Notice Paper No 1****Friday, 6 December 2024****Question No. 119**

MR BRADDOCK: To ask the Minister for Transport — What proportion of (a) rapid and (b) local bus service have come (i) on-time, (ii) late and (iii) early, for the last financial year.

Mr Chris Steel MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

Transport Canberra does not represent service punctuality in terms of whole services being late, on-time, or early.

Bus service punctuality is measured at the stop level and only at timing point stops (generally the first stop, last stop and other, intermediate stops referenced in published timetables on the Transport Canberra website). Performance is measured as the total number of stops departed by relevant bus services more than one-minute early, more than four-minutes late or on time, divided by all possible timing point stops departed by those bus services for the measured time period.

Bus service punctuality for the 2023-24 financial year is given in the table below:

	(a) Rapid	(b) Local
(i) On-time	73.65%	80.17%
(ii) Late	13.65%	12.64%
(iii) Early	12.70%	7.19%
