Is the Government aware of any instances where any self- assessment tool or tools related to conveyance duty liabilities or concessions has or may have provided an incorrect assessment or information?

No, the ACT Revenue Office has not advised me of any errors with the online self-assessment tool (homebuyer concession scheme questionnaire). The questionnaire returns an indicative result based on responses to the questions. If a person provides an incomplete or incorrect response, the indicative result will be based on the incomplete or incorrect information.

The ACT Revenue Office website content, online forms and self-assessment tools are regularly reviewed and updated to ensure they contain current and relevant information.


