Ms Deborah Morris MLA: To ask the Chief Minister

1. Are there any plans to upgrade or improve lighting in Petrie Plaza, specifically the carousel area; if so, what works are proposed and what is the expected timeframe for delivery.
2. Are there any plans to remove, relocate, or replace seating in Petrie Plaza, specifically the carousel adjacent; if so, what changes are proposed and what is the expected timeframe for delivery.

ANDREW BARR MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Yes - City Renewal Authority is planning to deliver new lighting in Petrie Plaza, including near the carousel, as part of the City Centre Lighting and Paving Upgrades project. A Managing Contractor was appointed in March 2026 to manage the design and construction. Timeframes for delivery will be confirmed once design is complete and staging plans have been developed.
2. The City Centre Lighting and Paving Upgrades project is expected to include minor alterations to the booth seating immediately west of the carousel. The design process to determine the nature of these changes will begin in April 2026 and take several months. Preoperatory works including demolition and infrastructure relocation of the existing seating and associated assets will commence in the coming months.
