Ms Jo Clay MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services

1. What traffic studies has the ACT Government conducted around Mount Rogers Primary School and Melba Preschool in the past 5 to 10 years.
2. What considerations for additional parking near and around Melba Oval have there been to provide more spots for people who need to do drop off and pick up, and more dedicated parking spots for sports and recreation events.

TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. No traffic studies have been conducted around Mount Rogers Primary School and Melba Preschool in the last 5 to 10 years. However, traffic surveys (to capture traffic data) were conducted on Alfred Hill Drive in 2017 and 2024 as well as Grainger Circuit in 2017.
2. Whilst the Melba 1 Oval, on Brownlee Place, had the pavilion upgraded in 2024, including the installation of two accessible parking spaces, the broader car parking requirements were not part of the scope of the project, which focussed on improving sporting facilities. Melba 2 Oval, a dryland oval on Alfred Hill Drive, does not have dedicated car parking spaces. Roads ACT has not conducted any investigations into additional parking facilities at the Melba District Playing Fields.
