RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**Questions on Notice Paper No 7****Friday, 16 May 2025****Question No. 459****MS BARRY:** To ask the Minister for City and Government Services —

1. Can the Minister clarify comments made in the Chamber on 6 May 2025 to the effect that you give priority to your scheduled maintenance program over responding to Fix My Streets requests, and does this mean that Fix My Street is no longer the appropriate way to refer issues.
2. Can the Minister advise why a constituent has been told that his requests (1089211 and 01089209 relating to graffiti on street signs on Ginninderra Drive) have been actioned, but the graffiti has not been removed from the signs.
3. Should constituents continue to be encouraged to use Fix My Street; if not, how should constituents raise their concerns.

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

1. I refer the member to the Hansard.
I did not advise that the maintenance program is given priority over other requests. All submissions lodged through Fix My Street are assessed and prioritised based on urgency and need. Where sensible and appropriate, requests may be incorporated into the broader work program. Fix My Street remains the most effective and preferred channel for the community to report maintenance issues.
2. Roads signs along Ginninderra Drive have experienced an increase in graffiti vandalism in recent times. TCCS internal crews have cleaned many signs in the corridor on multiple occasions, only to have them vandalised very soon after they have been cleaned. This appears to be the case for the two work requests mentioned. TCCS will be inspecting this section of Ginninderra Drive again over the coming weeks and removing any graffiti that is found.
3. Yes.
