Response to question on notice

Questions on Notice Paper No 09 05 September 2025 Question No. 611

Ms Jo Clay MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services

- 1. Has the ACT Government conducted any traffic studies on pedestrian crossings on College Street between Eastern Valley Way and Benjamin Way in the past five years.
- 2. Why is the part of College Street referred to in part (1) outside of the 40km/h zone in Belconnen centre, given it connects a residential area with the commercial hub in Belconnen.
- 3. Has there been any consideration for a pedestrian crossing in the part of College Street referred to in part (1) to provide better connectivity between the residential area and Belconnen centre.

TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1. Roads ACT undertook inspections for a pedestrian crossing request on College Street in 2024. No traffic studies were undertaken, as the location was deemed not suitable due to traffic lane configuration.
- 2. When the Belconnen Town Centre 40km/hr zone was established, that section of College Street was not considered suitable for inclusion as it did not have a strong commercial or retail frontage.
- 3. No, other than the initial review in 2024.
