

The specific data requested in this Question on Notice for the specific time series is not readily available.


The ACT Government provides annual reports to the Productivity Commission on 'Housing and Homelessness Services' as part of the Report on Government Services. This provides both a comparison with other jurisdictions and performance across time services.

Indicators include proportion of public and community housing, affordability, rental stress and dwelling effectiveness.

For the financial year, 2013-14 the Report on Government services is found at https://www.pc.gov.au/ongoing/report-on-government-services/2015/housing-and-homelessness

The most recent data covering the 2023-24 financial year will be released in late January 2025.

As reported by the Australian Bureau of Statistics, the estimated resident population of the ACT at June 2014 was 386,000 people; at June 2024 it was 474,132.
