## RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 3 7 March 2025 Question No. 185

MR CAIN MLA - To ask the Minister for Heritage:

- (1) How many submissions have been received in relation to the provisional registration of the Early Kingston Shops precinct (Blocks 1, 3-10 and 23-24, section 21 and (part) road verge, Kingston).
- (2) How many of the submissions were from (a) individuals and (b) groups.
- (3) Were all submissions received treated as individual submissions.

MINISTER STEEL MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) I am advised that a total of 55 submissions were received, including follow-up or multi-part submissions. Of these 53 were unique submissions.
- (2) Of the 53 unique submissions:
  - a. 50 submissions were from individuals
  - b. 3 submissions were from community groups
- (3) I am advised that all submissions were treated as individual submissions, and each was considered in detail by the Council.
