MR BRADDOCK: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services—

- 1. What is the estimated total capital cost for the (a) William Hovell Drive Duplication, (b) Monaro Highway Upgrade and (c) Molonglo River Bridge projects.
- 2. Is there (a) a business case, (b) a draft business case, (c) an economic appraisal, (d) an economic evaluation, (e) a benefits realisation report, or (f) other form of document serving a similar purpose, for each project referred to in part (1); if so, can the Minister provide a copy of each document.

## Ms Tara Cheyne MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

- a) The estimated total capital cost for the William Hovell Drive Duplication project is \$107.25 million. The final costs will be determined following completion of the procurement process.
- b) The estimated total capital cost for the Monaro Highway Upgrade is \$230.5 million. The final costs will be determined following completion of the procurement process for the remaining packages of work.
- c) The estimated total capital cost for the Molonglo River Bridge project is \$225 million.
