RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 7 16 May 2025 Question No. 445

MS MORRIS: To ask the Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services —

- 1. What is the target ambulance response time for Priority One incidents.
- 2. What was the median ambulance response time to Priority One incidents for each suburb within the Brindabella electorate in the calendar years of (a) 2019, (b) 2020, (c) 2021, (d) 2022, (e) 2023 and (f) 2025 year-to-date.
- 3. How many Priority One incidents occurred in each Brindabella suburb during the periods referred to in part (2).
- 4. How many instances was the Priority One response time target not met in each suburb during the periods referred to in part (2).

MARISA PATERSON MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Data on Priority One responses by ACT Ambulance Service (ACTAS) for each year from (1) to (4) 2019 to 2024 is publicly available in the Justice and Community Safety (JACS) Annual Reports and the Report on Government Services (ROGS). The data published in ROGS, which compares data from across Australian jurisdictions, shows that ACTAS consistently delivers some of the country's fastest response times.

> The ACT Emergency Services Agency (ESA) does not report figures on response times by electorate or suburb.

ACTAS stations are strategically located to service the needs and expectations of the whole community in relation to response times. These stations service all the ACT and are not restricted to specific suburbs.

The nearest available ambulance is always dispatched to an incident. The nearest available ambulance may not necessarily be the one from the nearest ambulance station. Those resources may, for example, be attending to another incident.
