MS NUTTAL MLA: To ask the Minister for Education and Early Childhood

What is the current average class size in ACT public schools, for the categories of (a) pre-school, (b) primary school, (c) high school and (d) college.

## YVETTE BERRY MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- a) In line with the Education Directorate's <u>Class Size Policy</u>, class sizes should not exceed the following number of students:
  - a. Preschools 22
  - b. Kindergarten to Year 3 21
  - c. Years 4 to 6 30
  - d. Years 7 to 9 32
  - e. Year 10 30
  - f. Year 11 and 12 25
- b) According to most recent data (2023), the average class sizes are:
  - a. Preschool 18.3
  - b. Primary (Kindergarten to Year 6)– 21.0
  - c. High School (Year 7 -10) 23.6
- c) The Education Directorate has not previously calculated average class sizes for Year 11 and 12 (Colleges) and this data is not currently available.
