
**Jo Clay MLA:** To ask the Minister for Climate Change, Environment, Energy and Water

1. What progress has been made in engaging a Government Landscape Architect.
2. Has the recruitment process commenced; if not, when is that process expected to start.

**SUZANNE ORR MLA** - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Work has been completed for the proposed scope for the Landscape Plan (LP), which will be used as a base to recruit the Landscape Architect. The LP will aim to take a long-term strategic approach to integrate and spatially resolve tensions between urban/infrastructure growth, climate adaption and nature conservation objectives. The City and Environment Directorate will directly recruit the Landscape Architect as a public servant.
2. The recruitment process has not formally commenced. It is expected to begin in January 2026.
