  - (e) 2024 and
  - (f) 2025 to present.
2. What are the projected enrolment numbers and maximum capacity for each of the schools referred to in part (1) for the 2026 school year.
3. How many students residing in the Brindabella electorate were enrolled in a public school outside the Brindabella electorate in
  - (a) 2020,
  - (b) 2021,
  - (c) 2022,
  - (d) 2023,
  - (e) 2024 and
  - (f) 2025 to present.
4. How many of the students referred to in part (3) were due to capacity constraints at their local public school.

These have been provided by the school noting actual outcomes may differ from anticipated enrolments and as such should be viewed as a general guide. Schools are listed in an alphabetical order. 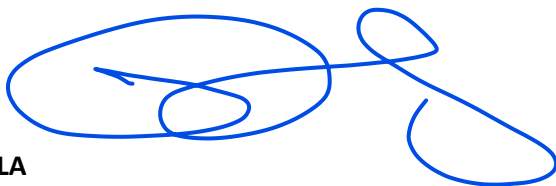
