Mr Peter Cain MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport

Can the Minister outline the Government's current plans for the installation of bus shelters across the ACT, including the criteria used to determine where shelters are prioritised and whether a shelter will be provided at bus stop 4881, Kinsella Street, on the main route to Kippax.

Mr Chris Steel MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The ACT Government considers a range of factors when determining where bus shelters are installed. These include passenger boarding volumes, the characteristics of the site, and whether the bus stop is located at a point where customers interchange between services.

Bus shelters are typically prioritised at bus stops with a high number of boarding passengers, where they benefit the greatest number of users. Bus stops where most passengers are alighting are generally not prioritised for bus shelter installation.

The request for a shelter to be installed at bus stop 4881 was referred to Transport Canberra for their consideration. I have been advised that based on the above criteria bus stop 4881 is not currently being considered as a high priority for the installation of a shelter relative to other bus stops across the Territory.
