**RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE****Questions on Notice Paper No 1****6 December 2024****Question No. 66****MS CLAY MLA** - To ask the Minister for Planning and Sustainable Development/Minister for Heritage:

- (1) Can the Minister provide a map of Canberra's current suburban footprint that shows (a) all suburbs that have been developed, (b) where development has begun and (c) where development has been approved.
- (2) Can the Minister provide a map of Canberra's footprint as currently planned with all suburbs that have been planned or that are in the current pipeline, including any that are in New South Wales.

**MINISTER STEEL MLA** - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

A map of Canberra's current suburban footprint, including where development has occurred and is currently expected to occur is best represented in the Territory Plan Map.

In the Territory Plan, anything within a residential, commercial, industrial, community facility, parks and recreation or transport and services zone can be reasonably considered to be within the suburban footprint, with non-urban zones outside the suburban footprint. Areas within the future urban area overlay are also an indication of where future development is expected to occur in the future.

As the Territory Plan only applies within the ACT, this does not outline potential future development within NSW as part of the Ginninderry development. This is best represented in the [West Belconnen](#)



[Strategic Assessment](#), undertaken by the proponent under the Commonwealth *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* for the entire development area.
