MR RATTENBURY MLA: To ask the Minister for Homes and New Suburbs

How many

- (a) public and
- (b) community housing dwellings,

do not meet minimum

- (i) energy efficiency and/or
- (ii) insulation standards, that apply to rental properties under the Residential Tenancy Act, as of 7 November 2024.

Yvette Berry MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The ACT Government introduced a regulation under the Residential Tenancies Act 1997 requiring all residential rental properties in the ACT meet a new minimum standard for energy efficient ceiling insulation. The standard came into effect on 1 April 2023 and will be phased in over a 4 year period, with most properties required to be compliant by 30 November 2026.

Housing ACT has approximately 3,500 public housing properties which require energy efficient ceiling insulation upgrades.

As of 7 November 2024, over 1,770 public housing properties have received insulation upgrades, representing 51% of the requirement.

This information relates to all properties owned by ACT Government are incorporated into the figures in part a, including those managed by Community Service Organisations on our behalf.
