MR RATTENBURY MLA: To ask the Minister for Homes and New Suburbs

- 1. What proportion of the market rent is charged for
 - (a) public housing,
 - (b) community housing that is

 - (b) not provided by an Aboriginal Community Controlled Housing Provider and
 - (c) affordable housing (rental).
- 2. What proportion of the occupier's income is charged for
 - (a) public housing and
 - (b) community housing that is
 - (i) provided by an Aboriginal Community Controlled Housing Provider,
 - (b) not provided by an Aboriginal Community Controlled Housing Provider and
 - (c) affordable housing (rental).
- 3. What is the proportion of households experiencing housing stress (that is, they are spending 30 percent or more of income on housing costs) for tenants living in
 - (a) public housing,

Yvette Berry MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1.

- a) Over 90 per cent of public housing tenants are on a rebate which guarantees they will not pay more than 25 per cent of their income for housing. The remaining tenants pay full market rent.
- b) The Territory is not privy to the arrangements between Community Housing Providers and their tenants.
- c) In general, affordable rental is charged at a rate that is less than 75 per cent of the current market rent.

2.

- a) Public housing tenants are protected by a rebate meaning they will generally not pay more than 25 per cent of their income on housing.
- b) The Territory is not privy to the arrangements between Community Housing Providers and their tenants.
- c) In general, affordable rental schemes, look to ensure tenants are not paying more than 30 per cent of their income on housing.

3.

- a) Public housing tenants should not be experiencing housing stress as they are protected by a rebate meaning they will generally not pay more than 25 per cent of their income on housing.
- b) The Territory is not privy to the arrangements between Community Housing Providers and their tenants.
- c) In general, affordable rental schemes, look to ensure tenants are not paying more than 30 per cent of their income on housing.
