RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 1 6 December 2024 Question No. 124

MR RATTENBURY MLA - To ask the Minister for Climate Change, Environment, Energy and Water:

- (1) What is the current number of electric vehicle chargers in the ACT that are (a) public and (b) private
- (2) What type of charger are they (e.g. DC fast charger).
- (3) Can the Minister provide a breakdown of each item listed in parts (1)(a), (1)(b) and (2), by electorate.

MINISTER ORR MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) As of 9th December 2024, there are 175 chargers available for public use in the ACT according to the website <u>PlugShare</u>. As some chargers have two plugs, there are 231 concurrent charging bays available for the public to use. Of those, 46 chargers (79 bays) have received ACT Government support, and 129 chargers (152 bays) are either privately funded or supported by Commonwealth Government grants.
- (2) There are 49 DC fast chargers (81 bays) and 126 AC chargers (150 bays).
