RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 3 Friday, 7 March 2025 Question No. 184

MR BRADDOCK: To ask the Minister for Transport —

- 1. Given that in the ministerial statement of 5 March 2025, the Minister for Transport mentioned "an 18 percent reduction in daily volume of motor vehicles compared to 2016" attributed to the operation of Light Rail Stage 1 (Civic to Gungahlin), can the Minister advise how this 18 percent figure was measured, and is it (a) only along Northbourne Avenue, (b) along a broader set of road routes, or (c) Territory-wide.
- 2. What is the source of the data referred to in part (1).
- 3. Can the Government provide the quarter of 2027 when construction is expected to be completed, given that the ministerial statement on 5 March 2025 also stated that construction on Light Rail Stage 2A is due to be completed in 2027.
- 4. How many light rail vehicles are expected to be deployed along the completed Light Rail Stages 1 and 2A (Commonwealth Avenue to Gungahlin).
