MS CLAY: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services —

Does the ACT have any arterial roads that are below 60 km/h, or have speed restrictions in place for limited periods, such as school zones during school hours; if so, what roads are they, and why was the decision made to lower the speed limit, even if for short periods of time.

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

The ACT has a number of arterial road sections that are below 60 km/h either on a permanent basis (in 40km/h precincts) or for limited periods (school zones during school hours) – see table below.

Road name	Reason for reduced speed limit
