Response to question on notice

Questions on Notice Paper No 8 Friday, 27 June 2025 Question No. 530

Mr Andrew Braddock MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services—

Does the ACT Government have plans to improve cycle paths around the Canberra Airport and Brindabella Park; if so, what are the (a) details of funding allocated and (b) timeframes for delivery for these plans.

TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

At this stage an off-road cycle path isn't planned along Pialligo Avenue along the southern portion of the Canberra airport and Brindabella Park.

ACT's <u>Active Travel Planning Tool</u> identifies that the ACT Government's intention is for the C9 Principal Cycle Route to connect to the Canberra airport and Brindabella Park at the western end of Nomad Drive near Fairbairn Avenue. Whilst a possible alignment has been identified through National Land, a new cycle path would be subject to planning approvals and funding through the Australian Government.
