MR EMERSON: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services —

- 1. Are there any red light cameras on the intersection of (a) Hindmarsh Drive and Jerrabomberra Ave and (b) Hindmarsh Drive and Mugga Lane.
- 2. If there are no red light cameras at those intersections referred to in part (1), is the Government considering installing cameras at those locations.

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

- 1. No. Information relating to the location of red-light cameras in the ACT can be found on the <u>ACT Government Open Data Portal</u>.
- The ACT Government has no immediate plans to expand fixed speed or redlight camera locations. A mobile speed camera van often operates in the vicinity of this location to monitor and enforce travel speeds.
