**MR THOMAS EMERSON MLA:** To ask the Minister for Skills, Training and Industrial Relations

1. When will the community be made aware of whether language programs currently offered through CIT Solutions will continue with CIT Solutions in 2026.
2. Will the Government guarantee the ongoing provision of a central delivery pathway for senior secondary language programs from 2026 for students to undertake language courses that are not available in their day schools.

**MICHAEL PETTERSSON MLA** - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Students undertaking senior secondary language courses have been contacted and are actively being enrolled at CIT for semester two, 2025. CIT will collaborate with students' home schools to support study pathways for the current year 11 cohort in 2026. I am advised that other languages programs are not transitioning as CIT doesn't currently offer language training.
2. The Education Directorate is working closely with the Board of Senior Secondary Studies regarding the future delivery of senior secondary language programs from 2026.
