4. ACT Policing investigates and prosecutes these matters where there is a willing complainant and where appropriate evidence and offenders are able to be identified.

ACT Policing utilises intelligence led policing to target several crime types including burglaries.

ACT Policing provides advice on its website as to how members of the community can target harden their homes to reduce the risk of becoming the victim of a break in. The website also includes information on the ACT Government funded SafeHome Program which aims to improve home security for households in the ACT that are vulnerable to property crime.
