RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 4 21 MARCH 2025 Question No. 211

MR EMERSON MLA: To ask the Minster for Health

- 1) How many presentations to all ACT hospital emergency departments in 2024 were related to or involved a dental or oral health issue.
- 2) What was the age group breakdown for those presentations referred to in part (1).

RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) is progressing a program of work to develop and publish a metric to publicly report the number of dental presentations to emergency departments. The requested data will be available in the coming months.

I can advise that in 2024, the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare reported that in the 2022-23 financial year, there were 1,589 hospitalisations in the ACT for dental procedures that were considered potentially preventable by timely and adequate dental care. This equates to a rate of 3.6 hospitalisations per 1,000 population.
