

## Response to question on notice

### Questions on Notice Paper No 9 5 September 2025 Question No. 584

**Leanne Castley MLA:** To ask the Attorney-General

1. Did the Minister extend the term of existing appointees to the motor vehicle repair industry advisory committee following the repeal of NI2018-490 or make new appointments to the committee.
2. Is there currently an active instrument related to the appointment of representative members for the motor vehicle repair industry advisory committee; if so, what is the instrument number.
3. Who are the current representative members of the motor vehicle repair industry advisory committee.
4. When did the committee last meet and when does the committee intend to meet next.
5. Are there currently arrangements planned or underway to expand the membership of the motor vehicle repair industry advisory committee beyond the six prescribed representative members; if so, how many new members are being added to the committee and what interests is each new member representing.

**TARA CHEYNE MLA** - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. On 5 March 2025, the *Better Regulation Legislation Amendment Bill 2025* (the Bill) was introduced in the Legislative Assembly. Part 9 of the Bill included the removal of Part 6 of the *Fair Trading (Motor Vehicle Repair Industry) Act 2010* (the Act), which provides for the establishment of the Motor Vehicle Repair Industry Advisory Committee (the Committee). The Bill was passed by the Legislative Assembly on 8 May 2025, with the amendments to the Act to commence on a day fixed by my written notice.<sup>1</sup> This notification was dependent of the new ACT Motor Vehicle Industry Stakeholder Meeting which first met on 22 October 2025.
