**Mr Andrew Braddock MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services**

How does the Government verify if roads and paths comply with anti-discrimination laws, accessibility standards and Australian Standards, including Austroads guides.

**TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:**

The existing roads and paths were built to comply with the internal standards and legislations of the time. New assets are built to the latest standards and specifications.

There is an ongoing program for public transport assets to be renewed to comply with the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992*. For example, existing bus stops are being improved to meet accessibility standards through an ongoing capital works program.

There is also a program that focusses on upgrading key safety elements of the road network, such as the replacement of safety barriers and terminal ends. As part of this program, assets are upgraded to the current relevant standards.
