LEANNE CASTLEY MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services -

Can the Minister provide information about loading zones in the city, including:

- a) how many loading zones there are currently in the CBD;
- b) a breakdown of the number of loading zones in the CBD for the last four years;
- c) an update on parking inspections and whether there is a schedule for inspectors to target non-commercial vehicles parking in a loading zone; and
- d) do these inspectors monitor Verity Lane?

TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- a) 223
- b) This information is unavailable, as the Traffic Control Device Grid is a 'live' document and updated regularly to reflect the physical on street parking restrictions.
- c) There is not a defined schedule for monitoring Loading Zones. Parking inspectors monitor all parking zones, which includes loading zones in their allocated patrol on the day.
- d) Parking inspectors monitor Verity Lane as part of their City patrol.
