RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 3 7 March 2025 Question No. 200

MR RATTENBURY: To ask the Minister for Gaming Reform —

- Which clubs have remaining concessions for planning related matters arising from the 1. surrender of gaming machine licences.
- What is the value of these remaining concessions. 2.

MARISA PATERSON MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Division 2A.2 of the Gaming Machine Act 2004, inserted in 2018 as part of the Pathway to 4,000 gaming machine authorisations in the ACT, provides for 'offset amounts' as financial incentives available to clubs that voluntarily surrendered gaming machine authorisations. The offset amounts can be applied against amounts payable to the Territory relating to a range of government land, lease, and planning and development charges. Clubs holding offset amounts must redeem these amounts before 1 April 2028.

The following table shows the status of offset amounts as at 24 March 2025.
