**RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**

**Questions on Notice Paper No 3**

**7 March 2025**

**Question No. 200**

**MR RATTENBURY:** To ask the Minister for Gaming Reform —

1. Which clubs have remaining concessions for planning related matters arising from the surrender of gaming machine licences.
2. What is the value of these remaining concessions.

**MARISA PATERSON MLA** - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Division 2A.2 of the *Gaming Machine Act 2004*, inserted in 2018 as part of the *Pathway to 4,000 gaming machine authorisations in the ACT*, provides for 'offset amounts' as financial incentives available to clubs that voluntarily surrendered gaming machine authorisations. The offset amounts can be applied against amounts payable to the Territory relating to a range of government land, lease, and planning and development charges. Clubs holding offset amounts must redeem these amounts before 1 April 2028.

The following table shows the status of offset amounts as at 24 March 2025.
