MISS NUTTALL: To ask the Minister for Sport and Recreation —

- 1. How many injuries have been reported due to the condition of ACT Government owned community sports fields and facilities, over the past year.
- 2. What is the process for reporting injuries that have occurred due to the condition of ACT Government-owned community sports fields and facilities

Ms Yvette Berry MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

- 1. TCCS Sports and Recreation Facilities (SRF) has had one reported incident in the 2024 calendar year.
- 2. Incidents in the past have been reported to TCCS team via a number of possible pathways:
 - (a). Via Access Canberra call centre who forward the information to the SRF management team.
 - (b). Via the sporting peak bodies directly to the SRF management team.
 - (c). Via legal representation direct to the TCCS legal team.
