RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 6 9 May 2025 Question No. 369

MR CAIN: To ask the Attorney-General —

- 1. How long has the current ACT Solicitor-General held the role in total.
- 2. How does this tenure compare to previous holders of the office in the ACT or in other iurisdictions.
- 3. Has the ACT Government received any internal advice, correspondence, or concerns suggesting that such a long tenure in the role may affect the independence, diversity, or adaptability of the office; if so, can the Attorney-General provide this information.
- 4. What specific strategic, institutional, or legal considerations were cited in the Cabinet submission (if one was prepared) to support a five-year extension rather than a shorter renewal or transition arrangement.
- 5. Is there a succession plan in place for the eventual transition of the Solicitor-General role.
- 6. Has the Government assessed whether prolonged incumbency could limit professional development or diversity in the senior ACT Government legal community; if so, can the Attorney-General provide the assessment.

- 1. The Solicitor-General has occupied the role since 2011.
- 2. The office of Solicitor-General was created in 2011
