RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 8 Friday, 27 June 2025 Question No. 500

MR BRADDOCK: To ask the Minister for Transport —

Can the Minister provide data, disaggregated by the transport modes of (a) light rail, (b) rapid bus routes, (c) local bus routes and (d) bus routes, on the proportion of public transport services compared to the maximum capacity in each category of fullness (0-20 percent, 21-50 percent, 51-80 percent, or 81-100 percent) for (i) weekdays peak, (ii) weekdays off-peak, (iii) Saturdays and (iv) Sundays.

Mr Chris Steel MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

The specific data requested is not currently within the scope of Transport Canberra's standard reporting.

With the transition to the MyWay+ ticketing system, the capture of public transport data has been temporarily paused to support the decommissioning of the old software and the rollout of MyWay+ across bus and light rail. The implementation team is continuing to refine the system by incorporating feedback, monitoring performance, and conducting extensive testing and validation to ensure data quality and reliability, before reporting resumes. Transport Canberra is in the process of migrating key business systems, which may temporarily affect the availability of certain datasets.

Currently, Transport Canberra are actively working with new system provider to explore opportunities to expand reporting capabilities.
