What was the fare revenue for the financial year 2022-23 received from (a) Concession cards, (b) Tertiary Student cards, (c) Student cards, (d) Adult MyWay cards, (e) Seniors cards, (f) Concession prepaid tickets, (g) Adult prepaid tickets and (h) all other card holders.

Mr Chris Steel MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

Fare revenue generated from passenger boardings on Transport Canberra buys and light services, by ticket category, for 2022-23 is listed in the table below:

Revenue (GST Exclusive)	2022-2023
(a) & (e) Concession	\$744,542
(b) Student - Tertiary	\$2,598,796
(c) Student	\$3,033,050
(d) Adult	\$14,876,371
(h) All other card holders	\$0
Total	\$21,252,758

The concession revenue includes senior concession. fares (f) (g) Concession prepaid tickets and adult prepaid tickets (understood as top up value) are not included as only passenger boarding revenue is included for reporting purposes.
