MS CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Access Canberra undertakes paid parking compliance activities across approximately 10,800 ACT Government-controlled parking spaces.

- (1) How much parking revenue has the Government collected from parking fees, broken down into the (a) City, (b) Tuggeranong, (c) Woden, (d) Gungahlin and (e) Belconnen areas for (i) 2022, (ii) 2021, (iii) 2020, (iv) 2019 and (v) 2018.

The following table contains the total amount paid (\$) in parking fees in each of the requested financial years, excluding GST.

Note: No ACT Government meters are located in Gungahlin district.
