MS CLAY: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services —

Has the ACT Government done any traffic studies for Aranda Primary School in the past ten years; if so, (a) what were the outcomes of this study and (b) did this study include whether a drop off/pick up zone was appropriate; if so, why wasn't a zone implemented; if not, why not.

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

- (a) Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS), through its School Safety Programs, has been supporting Aranda Primary School since March 2024.
- (b) A site inspection was undertaken which supported the establishment of a designated pick-up and drop-off zone on Bandjalong Crescent. TCCS is currently finalising plans to implement the pick-up and drop-off zone.

TCCS has finalised designs for improved pedestrian crossing provisions through the creation of a refuge island and intersection improvements via median strip extensions and new line markings at the corner of Bindel Street and Bandjalong Crescent. These improvements will be considered for delivery as part of a future capital works program.

TCCS also considered the installation of speed cushions, however traffic data showed average vehicle speeds were already below 40 km/h.
