# Response to question on notice

## **Questions on Notice Paper No 11** 26 September 2025 Question No. 671

#### LAURA NUTTALL MLA: To ask the Minister for the Public Service

- 1. Why was the tender process to engage an architect to design the new Woden Community Centre cancelled.
- 2. How many firms had submitted a tender for the process referred to in part (1).
- 3. Has the Minister advised the firms who submitted tenders for the process referred to in part (1) that the tender has been cancelled.
- 4. What is the process to deliver the Woden Community Centre.
- 5. When will the process referred to in part (4) commence.

### RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1. All tenders received for the Design of the new Woden Community Centre exceeded the available budgeted amount for this procurement. The ACT Government is currently considering a range of options to deliver this project within the available budget.
- 2. Five firms submitted a tender.
- 3. All five firms were sent a Letter of Decline advising that The Territory will not be proceeding with the procurement and all were offered a debrief by the Territory. Letters such as this are not sent by Ministers, noting that procurement processes are undertaken at arms-length from Ministers.
- 4. The Government is considering all available options to deliver the Woden Community Centre. Alongside the option to build a new community centre on the Callam Street, the Government is exploring alternative delivery models.
- 5. Infrastructure Canberra (iCBR) anticipates releasing a request for expressions of interest (EOI) regarding a leased option for an alternative location and building for a community centre in the Woden Town Centre in 2025-26. The EOI responses will inform future decisions about the delivery methodology and timing for the new community centre.
