Mr Peter Cain MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services

1. Has the ACT Government conducted any traffic or safety studies on Bowman Street West in the past two years.
2. Can the Minister advise why speed bumps have not been implemented on Bowman Street West.
3. Has the ACT Government undertaken any pedestrian or traffic safety assessments between the Southern Cross Club and Jamison Plaza in the past two years.
4. Does the Government plan on installing a zebra crossing to improve pedestrian safety and access between the Southern Cross Club and Jamison Plaza.
5. What criteria does the ACT Government apply when determining the need for pedestrian crossings at group centres.

TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Yes. A study was completed in January 2024.
2. As part of the concept development phase, speed humps on Bowman Street West were not deemed suitable due to constraints such as the risk to underground services, existing parking and the location of the bus stop.
3. Pedestrian and vehicle surveys at this location are currently being undertaken.
4. This will be assessed once the survey results have been received.
5. ACT Government active travel municipal infrastructure standards together with Austroads 'Guide to Road Design' will be used to determine suitable crossing treatments once data is available for assessment.
