RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 7 16 May 2025 Question No. 456


MS MORRIS: To ask the Attorney-General —

- 1. How many individual offenders in the ACT have been charged with two or more domestic and family violence-related (DFV) offences within a 12-month period in each of the last five reporting periods, including the 2024-25 period to present, and of those, how many resulted in at least one conviction.
- 2. How many individual offenders residing in the Electorate of Brindabella have been charged with two or more DFV-related offences within a 12-month period in each of the last five reporting periods, including the 2024-25 period to present, and of those, how many resulted in at least one conviction.
- 3. How many of the offenders referenced in parts (1) and (2) were granted bail following their first DFV-related charge.
- 4. How many of those granted bail committed a second DFV-related offence while on bail.
