Questions on Notice Paper No 8 Friday, 27 June 2025 Question No. 519

Mr Thomas Emerson MLA: To ask the Minister for City and Government Services—

- 1. Are there any red light cameras on the intersections of Hindmarsh Drive and Jerrabomberra Ave, or Hindmarsh Drive and Mugga Lane, to address road safety concerns raised about vehicles regularly running red lights on Hindmarsh Drive; if not, will the Government consider installing cameras at those locations.
- 2. How many road incidents have occurred at each of those locations referred to in part (1) over the past 12 months.

TARA CHEYNE MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:


There are no red-light cameras at the intersections of Hindmarsh Drive and Jerrabomberra
Avenue or Hindmarsh Drive and Mugga Lane. There is a procurement in progress to upgrade our
safety camera network; further comment on potential new sites would form part of that process.

2. Reported crash data for 2024 at the locations referred in question 1:

Intersection	Number of reported crashes
Hindmarsh Drive and Jerrabomberra	12
Avenue	(1 same direction side swipe + 11 rear-end crashes)
Hindmarsh Drive and Mugga Lane	8
	(1 right turn into oncoming vehicle + 1 same
	direction side swipe + 6 rear end crashes)

All of the above crashes were Property Damage Only crashes. Crash data for 2025 not provided as it is preliminary only and still not fully validated.
