RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE**Questions on Notice Paper No 3****7 March 2025****Question No. 161**

MR CAIN MLA - To ask the Minister for Climate Change, Environment, Energy and Water:

- (1) How many residents have applied for the Solar for Apartments program.
- (2) How many owners' corporations have applied for the Solar for Apartments program.
- (3) How many applications for the Solar for Apartments program have been finalised since the commencement of the program.
- (4) How many applicants have advanced to each stage of the process, as of the time of asking, including the stages of (a) quote submissions, (b) quote approval, (c) grant lock-in request approval, (d) installation and (e) any other stages involved in the program.
- (5) Which suburbs have applications for the Solar for Apartments program been submitted for.

MINISTER ORR MLA - The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) As of 12 March 2025, the Solar for Apartments Program has received total 88 registrations since the launch of the program, representing 3,649 apartment residents, including owner occupiers and renters.
- (2) A total of 63 owners' corporations have registered for the program, and some of these owners' corporations have submitted multiple applications for each distinct building within the owners' corporation.
- (3) As of 12 March 2025, two installations have been finalised and the solar systems have been energised.



(4) The following are the number of applications at each stage:

Installation completed	02

(5) The program has received applications from Aranda, Barton, Belconnen, Braddon, Campbell, Chifley, City, Denman Prospect, Dickson, Downer, Franklin, Griffith, Gungahlin, Hackett, Holt, Holder, Kingston, Lyneham, Melba, Narrabundah, O'Connor and Turner.
