## RESPONSE TO QUESTION ON NOTICE Questions on Notice Paper No 1 Friday, 6 December 2024 Question No. 53

MR BRADDOCK: To ask the Minister for Transport —

- 1. What is the status of network planning for future stages of the light rail beyond Stage 2 Civic to Woden, including but not limited to Stage 3 to Belconnen.
- 2. Is there an updated master plan, and when will it be released to the public.

## Mr Chris Steel MLA – The answer to the Member's questions are as follows:

1. The Government's current priority in relation to light rail is delivering Stage 2 to Woden, with planning, design and construction on projects like raising London Circuit and Stage 2A as well as the planning and design of Stage 2B.

The Government has set out further stages in the 'Future Light Rail Network Plan' and outlined potential light rail corridors in land-use planning undertaken in the development of District Strategies, including for Belconnen and the Inner North. The Government will consider refreshing the Network Plan this term, subject to other priorities.
